I. Satan before the fall

- Created by God
- Beautiful
- Covered in precious stones
- Full of musical instruments
- Sang (lead worship)
- He was perfect in all His ways
- Wise
- Named Lucifer
- Anointed Cherub
- Covers (The holy of Holies? The throne? The mercy seat?)
- Worked in the Holy height of God
- Walked amongst the stones of Fire

Ezekiel 28:13 MKJV You have been in Eden the garden of God; every precious stone was your covering, the ruby, topaz, and the diamond, the beryl, the onyx, and the jasper, the sapphire, the turquoise, and the emerald, and gold. The workmanship of your tambourines and of your flutes was prepared in you in the day that you were created.

Isaiah 14:12a KJV How art thou fallen from heaven, O Lucifer, son of the morning!

Isaiah 14:12a MKJV How you are fallen from the heavens, O shining star, son of the morning (Lucifer)

Lucifer H1984 heylel -- morning star

Job 38:4&7 MKJV (4) Where were you when I laid the foundations of the earth? Tell if you have understanding! (7) when the morning stars sang together and all the sons of God shouted for joy?

*Ezekiel 28:14-15 MKJV You were the **anointed cherub** that **covers**, and I had put you in the **holy height of God** where you were; **you have walked up and down in the midst of the stones of fire**. (15) You were **perfect in your ways** from the day that you were created, until iniquity was found in you.*

II. Satan's Rebellion and Removal from His Position

- Iniquity was found in Him
- Five I Statements
 - I will ascend into heaven.
 - I will exalt my throne above the stars of God.
 - I will sit also upon the mount of the congregation, in the sides of the north.
 - I will ascend above the heights of the clouds.
 - I will be like the Most High.
- Lead a rebellion in Heaven
- Merchandised His goods (rebellion and discontentment)
- Because of His beauty and His brightness he lead this rebellion
- He spoiled His wisdom
- Profaned the Holy Place
- There was war in Heaven
- Cast down to the ground
- He lost His place in Heaven

Isaiah 14:12-17 MKJV How you are fallen from the heavens, O shining star, son of the morning! How you are cut down to the ground, you who weakened the nations! (13) For you have said in your heart, I will go up to the heavens, I will exalt my throne above the stars of God; I will also sit on the mount of the congregation, in the sides of the north. (14) I will go up above the heights of the clouds; I will be like the Most High. (15) Yet you shall be brought down to hell, to the sides of the Pit. (16) Those who see you shall stare and closely watch you, saying, Is this the man who made the earth to tremble; who shook kingdoms; (17) who made the world as a wilderness, and destroyed its cities; who did not open the house for his prisoners?

*Ezekiel 28:16-18 MKJV (16) By the multitude of your **goods** they have filled your midst with violence, and you have sinned. So I cast you profaned from the height of God, and I destroy you, O covering cherub, from among the stones of fire. (17) Your heart was lifted up because of your beauty; you have spoiled your wisdom because of your brightness. I will cast you to the ground; I will put you before kings, that they may behold you. (18) By the host of your iniquities, by the iniquity of your trade, you have profaned your holy places; so I brought a fire from your midst; it shall devour you, and I will give you for ashes on the earth, before the eyes of all who see you.*

Verse 16 goods, trade, trading, traffic, merchandise (peddling discontentment and rebellion) leading a rebellion, turning the angels against God, traitor.

Rev 12:3-4a KJV And there appeared another wonder in heaven; and behold a great red dragon, having seven heads and ten horns, and seven crowns upon his heads. (4a) And his tail drew the third part of the stars of heaven, and did cast them to the earth:

Rev 12:7-9 KJV And there was war in heaven: Michael and his angels fought against the dragon; and the dragon fought and his angels, (8) And prevailed not; neither was their place found any more in heaven. (9) And the great dragon was cast out, that old serpent, called the Devil, and

Satan, which deceiveth the whole world: he was cast out into the earth, and his angels were cast out with him.

III. Satan Locked Away At the End of This Age

- He is cast into Hell at the end of this age
- The people in Hell will be amazed that Satan is as weak as they are and is receiving the same judgment that they received.
- His heavenly music had become nothing but noise
- He will be covered in hell with maggots
- He will be bound in hell for 1000 years

*Isaiah 14:9-11 MKJV Hell from below is moved for you, to meet you at your coming. It stirs up the dead for you, all the he-goats of the earth. It has raised from their thrones all the kings of the nations. (10) All of them shall speak and say to you, Are you also as weak as we? Are you like us? (11) **Your pride is brought down to the grave, and the noise of your harps.** The maggot is spread under you, and the worms cover you.*

Revelation 20:1-3 MKJV And I saw an angel come down from Heaven, having the key of the abyss and a great chain in his hand. (2) And he laid hold on the dragon, that old serpent, who is the Devil and Satan, and bound him a thousand years. (3) And he cast him into the abyss and shut him up and set a seal on him, that he should deceive the nations no more until the thousand years should be fulfilled. And after that he must be loosed a little time.

IV. Satan's Final Rebellion and End

- Satan will be loosed at the end of the 1000 years
- He will lead one final rebellion
- He will deceive many once again (as many as the sand of the sea)
- They will surround the saints and the Holy City
- Fire will come out of heaven and devour them all
- He will be cast into the Lake of Fire and Brimstone
- He will be tormented day and night forever and ever.

Revelation 20:7-10 MKJV (7) And when the thousand years have expired, Satan will be loosed out of his prison. (8) And he will go out to deceive the nations which are in the four quarters of the earth, Gog and Magog, to gather them together to battle. The number of them is as the sand of the sea. (9) And they went up over the breadth of the earth and circled around the camp of the saints, and the beloved city. And fire came down from God out of Heaven and devoured them. (10) And the Devil who deceived them was cast into the Lake of Fire and Brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet were. And he will be tormented day and night forever and ever.

V. Satan's Character Revealed in His Names

I have provided only one scripture reference for each name. Some of his names are used many times throughout the Bible. The names used for Satan may change some from one translation of the Bible to another. Here I used the Modern King James Version.

Abaddon	Revelation 9:11	The destroyer
Apollyon	Revelation 9:11	A destroyer
Beelzebub	Matthew 10:2	Lord of the flies, dung god
Belial	2 Corinthians 6:15	Wicked, worthless
Satan	Matthew 4:10	Contrary, adversary, enemy, accuser (Most commonly used name for him)

Descriptive names that give insight into Satan's power

Angel of the Abyss	Revelation 9:11	Abyss: the abode of evil spirits, hell
The prince of demons	Mark 3:22	Prince: ruler or the first in rank of power
The prince of the power Of the air	Ephesians 2:2	Ruler of demons
God of this world	2 Corinthians 4:4	False god, idol, ruler. He is god of those that are of this world and its systems.



Other Descriptive Names

The serpent	II Corinthians 11:3	A subtle, sly or treacherous person
Dragon	Revelation 12:9	Brings to mind a vicious, wicked animal
The accuser of the brothers	Revelation 12:10	Satan accuses God's people of wrongdoing in order to try to disqualify us, not only as God's children but also as one's having dominion under God's leadership. He cannot because

		Jesus has paid our sin debt.
Antichrist	1 John 4:3	He works to turn peoples minds and hearts away from Christ through lies, false teachings, persecution, etc.
The enemy	1 Peter 5:8	One who feels hatred toward, intends injury to, or opposes the interests of another; a foe. A hostile power or force
A liar	John 8:44	Someone who lies repeatedly
Father of lies	John 8:44	The one behind all lies.
The lawless one	2 Thessalonians 2:8-9	One who is unruly, or unrestrained by law, rebellious, no scruples
Murderer	John 8:4	Has killed, has no value of life
The tempter	Matthew 4:3	One who entices someone to do wrong. Satan tempts hoping to bring about our or someone else's demise.
The thief	John 10:10	One who steals repeatedly. Satan desires to steal everything good from us.
The evil one	Matthew 5:37	Angry, atrocious, bad, beastly, corrupt, damnable, depraved, destructive, disastrous, foul, harmful, hateful, heinous, hideous, iniquitous, injurious, loathsome, low, malicious, no good, obscene, offensive, poison, reprobate, repulsive, revolting, rotten, sinful, spiteful, stinking, ugly, unpleasant, vicious, vile, villainous, wicked, wrathful, wrong
