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INTRODUCTION

The presence of the Lord is absolutely glorious and we, His covenant children, have been invited to not only know Him but to experience His glory and fullness.

In Revelation 4:1,2 we find John being given an invitation to enter into heaven. He entered immediately at beheld realms of glory that he describes for us in vivid imagery. He saw the throne and the One sitting on the throne. He saw the 24 elders and their thrones. He experienced the lightening and the thundering sounds of glory. He saw colors, crowns, holy attire, the rainbow, and he beheld “...*seven lamps of fire burning before the throne, which are the seven Spirits of God.*” (Revelation 4:5b)

Many Bible theologians agree that the seven Spirits of God actually refer to, the seven-fold dimensions of God’s Spirit. I personally believe this but also believe that the Lord has created companies of angels who minister specific dimensions of His character and nature as well.

In this course we will look at the character, nature, and functions of the Holy Spirit and teach how every believer can operate and function in the graces He has offered us. We will also look at the ministry of angels and how they have been created to minister to the heirs of salvation.

WHO IS THE HOLY SPIRIT?

A WHO IS THE HOLY SPIRIT?

1. He is a PERSON and not a mere influence or power.
2. He is referred to as part of the Godhead. (Matthew 28:19)
3. He is the Promise of the Father. (Acts 2:33; Acts 1:4,5)
4. He is referred to as “Lord.” (2 Corinthians 3:18)
5. He is a gift to us. (Acts 2:38)
6. He comes from heaven (1 Peter 1:12)
7. He is the “SPIRIT” of the Godhead. (Romans 8:9,14)
8. Spirit of the Father. (Matthew 10:20)
9. Spirit of the Son. (Galatians 4:6)
10. Spirit of Jesus Christ. (1 Peter 1:11)
11. Spirit of the Lord. (2 Cor 3:17; 2 Cor 3:18; Acts 8:39; Luke 4:18; Acts 5:9)

The Holy Spirit is the enabling power of God who is given as a gift (Acts 1:4,8; 2:38; 10:38,45) to the church and multiplies gifts within the church.

He is the “Paraclete” (John 14:26; 16:7) who comes along side the believer to “guide into all truth” (John 16:13) and to “help us in our weakness” (Romans 8:26).

The Spirit comforts by testifying with our spirit that we are God’s children (Romans 8:16) and He is our perfect advocate before a holy God. He intercedes or speaks for us with “groans that words cannot express...in accordance with God’s will” (Romans 8:26,27).

As an advocate to the believer, He combines the work of a friend who clearly tells what is wrong (advocate can mean: prosecuting counsel, defending counsel or friend), but only so that, once it is exposed, it can be put right. The Holy Spirit will dispel illusion but maintain perfect love towards the offender.

He is the creative power of God and His very presence brought order into chaos (Gen 1:1,2). The Holy Spirit is the Father’s gift of love to us.

LESSON TWO

THE SEVENFOLD SPIRIT OF GOD

A. THE SEVENFOLD NATURE OF THE HOLY SPIRIT (Introduction)

NOTE: The sevenfold Spirit of God is described as being before the throne (place of divine authority).

1. Revelation 1:4
...Grace to you and peace from Him who is and who was and who is to come, and from the seven Spirits who are before the throne. NAS

2. Revelation 3:1
...He who has the seven Spirits of God and the seven stars, says this... NAS

...these are the words of Him Who has the seven Spirits of God {the sevenfold Holy Spirit} and the seven stars. AMP

3. Revelation 4:5
Out from the throne come flashes of lightning and sounds and peals of thunder. And there were seven lamps burning before the throne, which are the seven Spirits of God. NAS

Out from the throne came flashes of lightning and rumblings and peals of thunder, and in front of the throne seven blazing torches burned, which are the seven Spirits of God {the sevenfold Holy Spirit}. AMP

Lightning flash and thunder crash pulsed from the Throne. Seven fire-blazing torches fronted the Throne (these are the Sevenfold Spirit of God). THE MESSAGE

4. Revelation 5:6
And I saw between the throne (with the four living creatures) and the elders a Lamb standing as if slain, having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God sent out into all the earth. NAS

And there between the throne and the four living creatures (beings) and among the elders {of the heavenly Sanhedrin} I saw a Lamb standing as though it had been slain with seven horns and with seven eyes, which are the seven Spirits of God {the sevenfold Holy Spirit} who have been sent {on duty far and wide} into all the earth. AMP

5. Isaiah 11:2

The Spirit of the Lord will rest on Him. The spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and strength (might), the spirit of knowledge and the fear of the Lord.

- a. The Spirit of the Lord.
- b. The spirit of wisdom.
- c. The spirit of understanding.
- d. The spirit of counsel.
- e. The spirit of strength (might).
- f. The spirit of knowledge.
- g. The spirit of the fear of the Lord.

B. THE SIGNIFICANCE OF SEVEN

According to the Dictionary of Biblical Imagery (General Editors: Leland Ryken, James C Wilhoit, Tremper Longman III), The number seven, in biblical usage signifies completeness or totality. The following is a quote from p 774:

The symbolism of completeness occurs in a wide variety of uses of the number seven. For example, sprinkling of the blood of a sacrifice seven times (Lev 16:14,19) indicates complete purification. The seven “eyes of the Lord, which range through the whole earth” (Zech 4:10 NRSV), indicate the completeness of God’s sight of everything in His creation. When the prophet John sees the Lamb, an image of Christ, “having seven horns and seven eyes, which are the seven spirits of God sent out into all the earth” (Rev 5:6 NRSV; cf. 1:4; 3:1; 4:5), the seven spirits are the fullness of the Divine Spirit, going out into the world as the Spirit of Christ with complete power (“seven horns”) and complete knowledge and insight (“seven eyes”).

C. DEVELOPING A RELATIONSHIP WITH THE HOLY SPIRIT

The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all.” 2 Cor 13:14

1. Acknowledge Him – His presence, His gifts, His nature; His functions
2. Thank Him for coming to you.
3. Invite Him to take control of your life and decisions.
4. Invite Him to lead you and to counsel you. (Remember, He authored the scriptures – 2 Peter 1:20,21)
5. Wait for Him, Soak, Drink, Fellowship (dialogue) with Him as you would with a friend.
6. Journal and Meditate
7. Look for Him and His activities throughout your day.
8. Be available to Him should He desire to use you to release His manifested presence.
9. Be ready to obey Him.
10. Repent when you sense that you have grieved Him.
11. Enjoy Him.
12. Rest in His love and receive Him as your best friend. He is the Spirit of Jesus Christ!

D. THE SEVENFOLD SPIRIT OF GOD AND THE ANGELS

1. God is God – a 3 part/Triune God: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.
2. The Holy Spirit is expressed through a 7-fold manifestation.
 - a. ie. Our physical body has individual organs with specific functions but they are still part of our physical body.
3. Angels are created beings. God is not an angel and angels are not God. (Hebrews 1)

- a. The Holy Spirit is not an angel.
 - b. The “seven Spirits of God” are not angels – they are dimensions of the Holy Spirit.
4. Angels are created by God to:
- a. represent specific aspects of His nature (i.e. God IS Wisdom but has also created angels of wisdom to specifically reflect and function in the operation of His wisdom.)

LESSON THREE

THE SEVEN

The Spirit of the Lord will rest upon Him, The spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and strength (might), the spirit of knowledge and the fear of the Lord. Isaiah 11:2

B. THE SPIRIT OF WISDOM

1. Wisdom Defined:

a. From Webster's Dictionary and Thesaurus

The quality of being wise; power of judging rightly and following the soundest course of action, based on knowledge, experience, understanding, etc.; good judgment; sagacity, good sense, astuteness, discreet, rational

b. Applied knowledge

- To know what to do, when to do it, and how to do it, in every situation.
- The force that teaches you how to apply knowledge; to apply what you know.

c. To see Jesus as He fully is. (Ephesians 1:17-23)

- Jesus is the wisdom of God. (1 Cor 1:30)

d. The ability that helps you to articulate revelation. Isa 50:4

- Wisdom and revelation (understanding) work together. (Eph 1:17)

2. Qualities and attributes of wisdom

a. From James 3:17 Amp

But the wisdom from above is first of all pure (undefiled); then it is peace-loving, courteous (considerate, gentle), [It is willing to] yield to reason, full of compassion and good fruits; it is wholehearted, straightforward, impartial and unfeigned (free from doubts, wavering, and insincerity).

- purity
- peace-loving
- courteous, considerate
- gentle
- easily entreated; yields to reason; reasonable
- full of compassion
- full of good fruits (fruit of the Spirit, righteousness)
- wholehearted
- straightforward and honest
- impartial and without prejudice, without hypocrisy
- without doubt, insincerity, unbelief

3. Some benefits of wisdom (From Proverbs Chapters 1-9)
 - a. increase in learning (Prov 1:5)
 - b. receive instruction in wise behavior, righteousness and fairness (Prov 1:3)
 - c. live securely (Prov 2:33; 3:23)
 - d. deliverance from evil (Prov 2:12)
 - e. walk in the way of good men; keep on path of righteousness. (Prov 2:20)
 - f. length of days and peace (Prov 3:2,16; 9:11)
 - g. favor, honor, good repute with God and man (Prov 3:4,16,35; 4:8; 8:35)
 - h. healing and refreshment to your body (Prov 3:8)
 - i. financial prosperity. (Prov 3:9,10,16; 8:18,19;21)
 - j. blessed life and dwelling (Prov 3:13,18,33; 8:32-34)
 - k. life to your soul and adornment (Prov 3:20; 4:9; 8:35)
 - l. deliverance from fear (Prov 3:24,25)

4. Wisdom is portrayed through biblical imagery as that of the personified woman:
 - a. She is a commanding presence who summons people in the city, market places, streets, on top of the walls and the city gates. (Prov 1:20,21)
 - b. She is an alluring woman who builds a house and invites people to a lavish banquet of food and wine. (Prov 9:1-12)

5. Wisdom and creation.
 - a. By wisdom the Lord founded the earth. Prov. 3:19,20
 - b. Wisdom was with God in creation. Prov 8:22-31
6. Wisdom and revelation work together. Isaiah 11:2; Eph 1:17,18

C. THE SPIRIT OF UNDERSTANDING (Spirit of Revelation)

*[For I always pray to] the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, that He may grant you a spirit of wisdom and revelation [of insight into mysteries and secrets] in the [deep and intimate] knowledge of Him,
By having the eyes of your heart flooded with light, so that you can know and understand the hope to which He has called you and how rich is His glorious inheritance in the saints (His set apart ones);
And [so that you can know and understand what is the immeasurable and unlimited and surpassing greatness of His power in and for us who believe, as demonstrated in the working of His mighty strength,
Which He exerted in Christ... Ephesians 1:17-20a AMP*

1. The spirit of understanding (revelation) enables you to:
 - a. know Jesus
 - b. know your calling in Him
 - c. understand the greatness of His power.
 - d. to understand truth and its mysteries
2. The things revealed by God belong to us.
The secret things belong unto Jehovah our God; but the things that are revealed belong unto us and to our children for ever, that we may do all the words of this law. Deut 29:29
3. The Apostle John was influenced by the spirit of revelation and wrote the Book of The Revelation of Jesus Christ. (Rev 1:1; Eph 1:17,18)
4. The Apostle Paul was enlightened concerning the gospel and the Kingdom of God through revelation. Galatians 1:12

5. Imagery of “eyes”
 - a. Rev 5:6 “...and seven eyes which are the seven Spirits of God, sent out into all the earth.” NAS
 - b. Eph 1:18 “I pray that the eyes of your heart (understanding) may be enlightened....” NAS
 - by the spirit of revelation (Eph 1:17)
6. Understanding (Revelation) and Wisdom work together.
 - a. Isa 11:2 “....spirit of wisdom and understanding.
 - b. Eph 1:17 “...spirit of wisdom and revelation.”

E. THE SPIRIT OF COUNSEL

1. Definition: counsel, advice, strategies, plans, exchange of ideas, confidential idea, secret.
2. God wants to reveal His secrets to us:
 - a. Deut 29:29 “The secret things belong unto Jehovah our God; but the things that are revealed belong unto us...”
 - b. Amos 3:7 “Surely the Lord does nothing unless he reveals His secret counsel to His servants the prophets.”
 - c. Jeremiah 23:18 “But who has stood in the council (place of His counsel) of the Lord, that he should see and hear His word? Who has given heed to His word and listened?”
 - d. Psalm 16:7 “I will bless the Lord who has counseled me; Indeed my mind instructs me in the night.”
 - e. Job 29:2,3, 21-25 – Job knew the friendship of God that was over his tent. He received the counsel of God and shared it with those in the city. “To me they listened and waited, and kept silent for my counsel.” (v 21)

3. God gives strategies through the Spirit of Counsel for Kingdom advancement.
 - a. Moses received the counsel of God concerning the building of the tabernacle in the wilderness. Ex 25
 - b. Joshua received the ongoing counsel of the Lord concerning taking the children into the promised land. (Book of Joshua).
 - c. Jesus only did the things He saw His Father do. John 5:19
 - d. God counsels with His “eye” upon us.
“I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go; I will counsel you with My eye upon you.” Psalm 32:8
 - e. Wait on God for counsel and then move in “might”.

F. THE SPIRIT OF MIGHT

1. Definition: Strength, might, mighty works, miracles, supernatural energy, acts of power.
2. The spirit of counsel is given before might is exercised.
3. Example of Moses
 - a. Before Pharaoh
 - Exodus 3- 7 God’s counsel and the unfolding of the plan.
 - Exodus 7 Moses begins to execute the plan and God’s power is manifest.
 - b. The crossing of the Red Sea
 - Ex 12 God gives counsel to Moses concerning the Passover and the Exodus.
 - Ex 14 God’s powerful and miraculous victory is made manifest.
4. Example of Jesus and the apostles regarding the outpouring of the Spirit.
 - a. Acts 1:4-8 - Jesus gives counsel regarding the Holy Spirit.
 - b. Acts 2 - The power of the Holy Spirit comes.

5. Example of Joshua and Jericho
 - a. Joshua 6: 1-11 -- The strategy/counsel is given
 - b. Joshua 6:12-19 – The counsel is carried out
 - c. Joshua 6:20-21 – The miracle working power of God was displayed.
 - d. Joshua 6:22- 7 – The consequence of disobedience.
6. Example of Jesus feeding the 5,000
 - a. Luke 9:12-14 The strategy
 - b. Luke 9:15,16 Implementation
 - c. Luke 17 The miracle.
7. They that “wait” upon the Lord will renew their strength. Isa 40:29-31
8. Elijah was supernaturally strengthened.
 - a. outran Ahab to Jezreel 1 Kings 18:46
 - b. strengthened by angels food. 1 Kings 19:1-8
9. Samson had a spirit of might.
 - a. *The Spirit of the Lord came upon him (Samson) mightily, so that he tore him (the lion) as one tears a young goat though he had nothing in his hand... Judges 14:6*
 - b. Samson is avenged (Judges 14:28 – 30) His final act of might killed more Philistines at his death than in all the years before.

G. THE SPIRIT OF KNOWLEDGE

1. Defined:
 - a. the God-given ability to know things that are impossible to know in the natural. (i.e. words of knowledge).

- b. perception, skill, discernment.
 - c. state of knowing; acquaintance with facts and principles, enlightenment.
 - d. supernatural intellectual ability.
 - e. knowledge of witty inventions; creative inspiration (Proverbs 8:12)
2. Knowing details (i.e names, sickness, addresses etc)
 3. Example: Jesus with the woman at the well. John 4:15-18
 4. Example: Jesus “knowing their thoughts.” Matt 9:4; Mark 2:6-9
 5. Example: Ananias and Sapphira Acts 5:1-11
 6. Discernment in the realm of the spirit. Luke 10:17; Acts 16:16-18
 7. The beginning of knowledge is the
fear of the Lord. Proverbs 1:7
